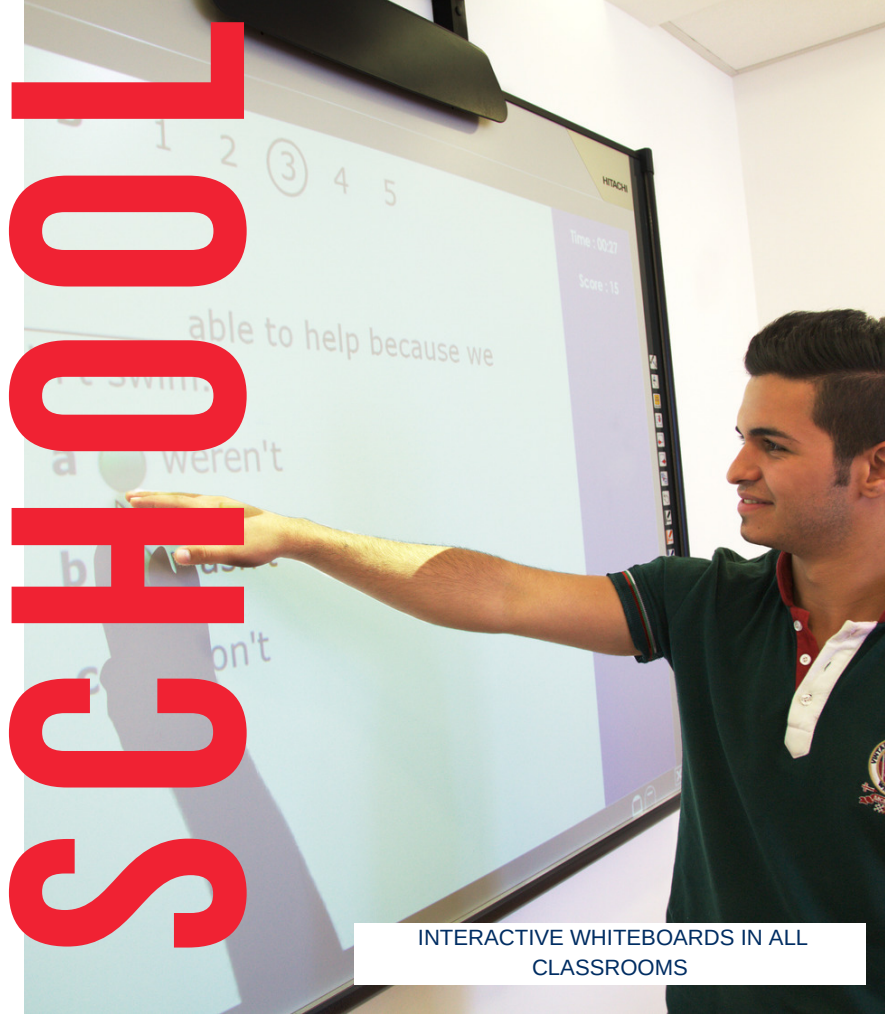


DIVING SPOT AT EXILES

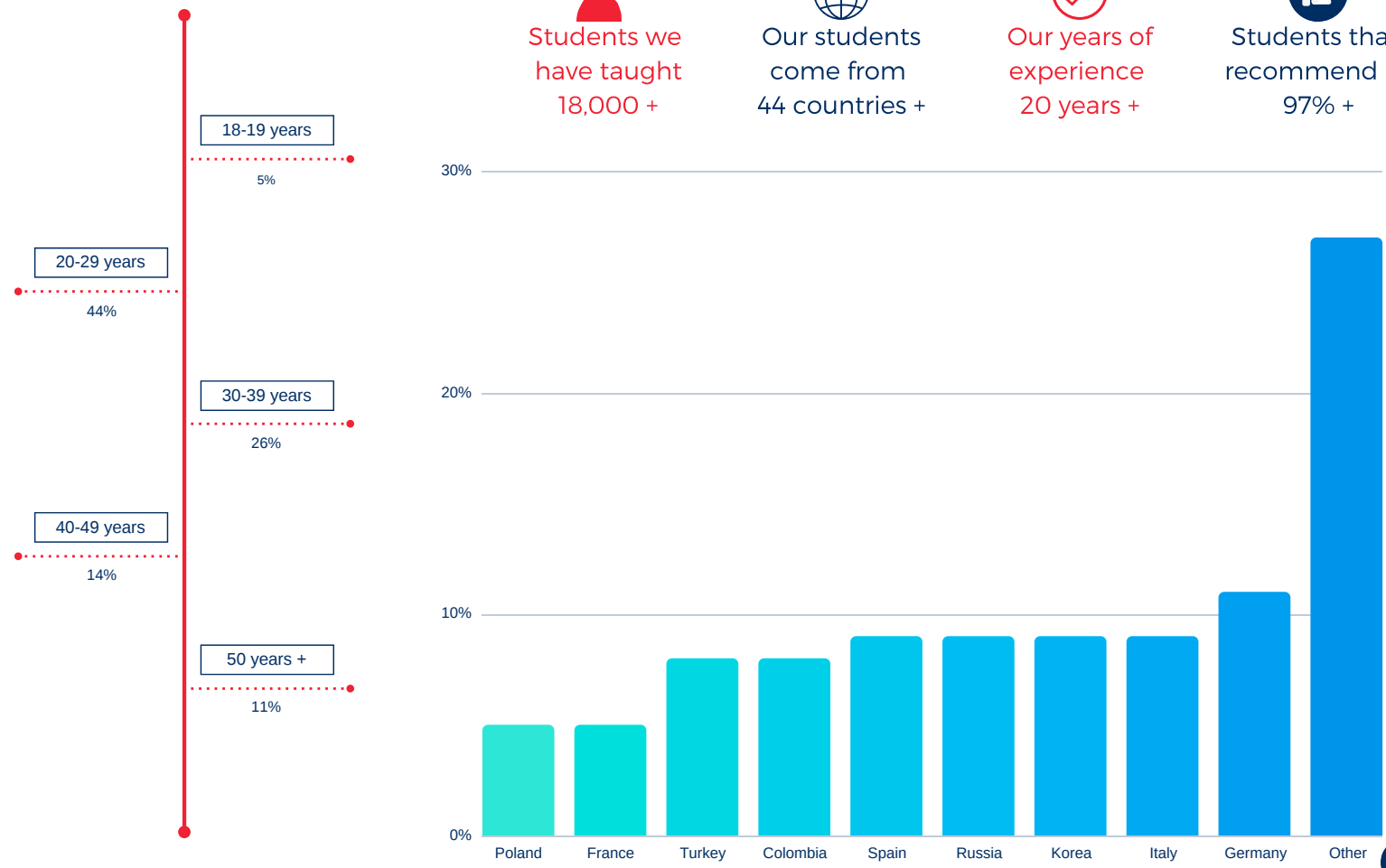

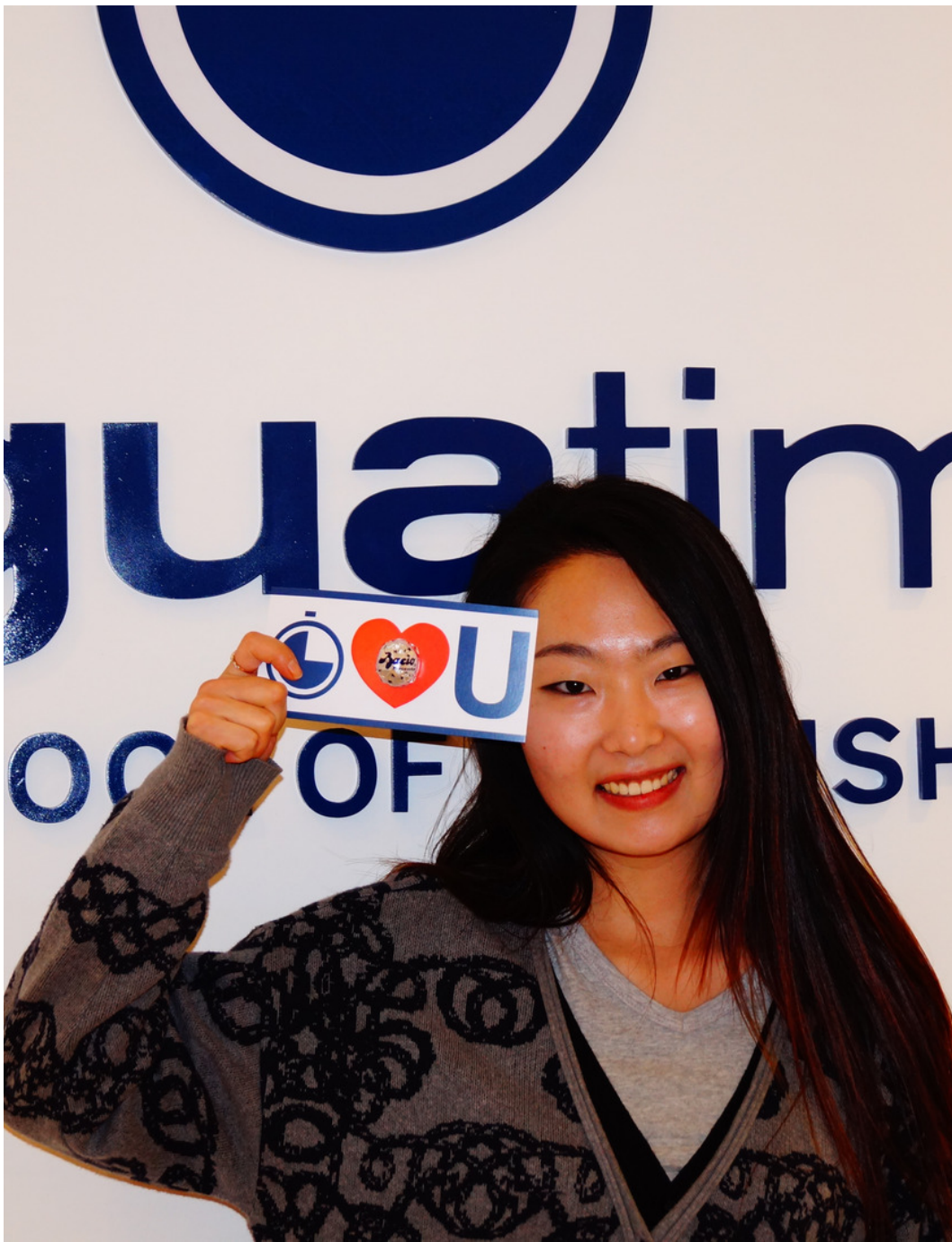

If your job requires you to use English on a regular basis, then this programme will give you plenty of time and scope to practice your English communication and language skills.

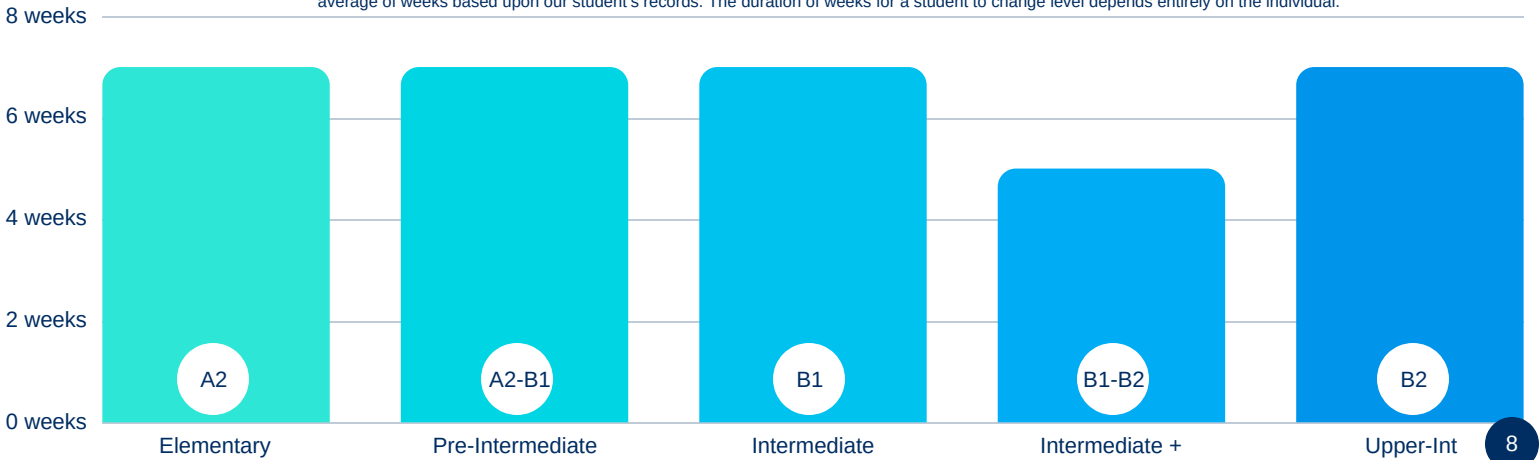
Whether in a corporate, field-specific or social setting, the right language skills will enable you to do business in a better and more efficient manner.

The graph below is based on the General English Group 20 course. It is recommended to upgrade to more lessons in order to learn faster. The stated weeks in the graph are an approximate average of weeks based upon our student's records. The duration of weeks for a student to change level depends entirely on the individual.



Online & Level Tests

Before starting your course, upon booking, you will receive the online test instructions. We recommend that students sit for the online test well in advance. If students do not sit for the online test before arrival, there is the possibility that they will miss the first 2 lessons of the morning.

When students feel ready to advance from one level to another they are encouraged to speak to their teachers. It is the teacher and students that decide when the level test can be taken. Level tests are held weekly in the afternoon.

ACCOMMODATION IN MALTA

SHARED SELF-CATERING APARTMENTS

If you'd prefer the freedom of an apartment, then our self-catering shared apartments could be ideal for your time in Malta.

Generally located within walking distance of the school, each apartment has varied facilities, including a fully-equipped kitchen, a living and dining area, free Wi-Fi in the common area and comfortable bedrooms. All of the apartments are self-catering so meals are not included, which means you could choose to cook for yourself, to combine meals with your flat mates, or to check out the nearby cafés and restaurants. This is actually a great way of making friends, and gives you plenty of opportunities to practice your English skills.

Single rooms, twin rooms and triple/quad rooms are available and you can also request to share with students from different countries, which will give you more opportunities to practice speaking in English.

HOMESTAY

If you'd really like to immerse yourself in the English-speaking experience, what better way is there than by staying with an English-speaking family?

Throughout your stay, you'll join your hosts for meals and have plenty of opportunities to chat, while living in a welcoming environment that will come to feel like a home away from home. Of course you'll also have plenty of freedom to explore Malta at your own pace, possibly taking the advice of your hosts as they make their suggestions for the places you should visit while you're here.

Different host families offer a variety of facilities, but will always include breakfast and dinner every day, as well as an optional packed lunch. Most homestay rooms accommodate up to four students, though single rooms are usually available at an additional cost.

HOTELS

If you're looking for complete freedom, your own space and a range of leisure amenities, then a hotel may be the right accommodation choice for you.

Malta is known for its hospitality, and there is a fantastic range of hotels within easy reach of Linguatime.

These hotels, which include establishments in the three-, four- and five-star categories, are all located in Sliema and St Julian's, giving you easy access to nearby sights and attractions.

While the facilities available depend on your budget and chosen hotel, most offer excellent amenities for your stay. These include en-suite bathrooms, swimming pools, sea views, concierge services and in-house restaurants, as well as 24-hour room service, Wi-Fi and high speed Internet access, and safety deposit boxes are usually at a charge.

Walk Around Valletta

Like most capital cities, Valletta is a very busy place and it is easy to get caught up in that. Nevertheless its personality is quite unique, and best enjoyed in quiet, perhaps from a pavement café, while walking through the backstreets, or while reading a book in one of the public gardens. It will give you a different perspective.



See The Temples

As the oldest free-standing stone structures in the world (yes, even older than the pyramids!), the prehistoric Maltese temples are pretty incredible. All five of them are listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites, and it's worth visiting all of them as they uniquely shed light on the island's past.



Visit Gozo and Comino

Malta's smaller sister islands offer something quite different. Gozo, the larger of the two, still has lots of towns and villages, but is also far more rural. It's a great place to ride your bike or find a secluded beach for a swim. Comino, known for the bright Blue Lagoon, is very busy in summer, but is a must-see for its incredible turquoise waters.



Mdina

Travel back in time and walk through the quiet alleys around Mdina, another UNESCO World Heritage Site. This stunning fortified city, which sits majestically on a hill, is still home to many of Malta's noble families today, and it has a very regal feel to it. It's also very romantic, and ideal as a destination for an evening stroll or a special dinner.



A Village Festa

Really get into the Mediterranean spirit with a trip to a local festa – a celebration of a town's patron saint. Mixing religion with revelry, each village comes alive with live music, food, street parties and fireworks. They are held throughout the summer and make for a wonderful evening under the stars!
